We had the joy of seeing the first baptisms among the group of Cambodians who regularly attend Bible study for several months now (Photos on the top).



The next day we went to an area where several Burmese came to hear the gospel. We had a game followed by prizes for the winners and then a moment of listening to the word and an invitation to receive Christ as their personal Savior. The atmosphere was filled with joy.



The third day, divided into different groups, we went in front of high schools to proclaim the Gospel. I was personally touched by a group of girls. At first some of them laughed when we started to present the gospel using the "evangecube," an outreach tool with support of images ; but gradually, a great concentration took place. They have become very attentive when they see the risen Jesus out of the tomb. They agreed to pray with us. We are sure that God will continue his work in their hearts, Phil 1: 6.

During these three days, we were able to not only share the gospel with many but we were ourselves filled with the life of God. My heart cries "thank you Lord!"
