During the renovation I had a lesson in practice right from the Bible: the enemy is the same as it was in the time of Nehemiah. It doesn't want us to be here and that one of the most infamous disco would turn into a GGWO church. So I met Sanballat and Geshem of the XXI century. (Neh. 2-3). Literally I was building the wall when I received calls which said: Come down off the wall, stop building it, you will be kicked out of this place! By the effect of the pressure the church started to pray as one man and by next month the walls of the church got ready and we could organize the SEPSICON.

SEPSICON was a real surprise to everyone. We didn't want this because we didn't have the capacity to organize it. But GOD! The idea came only in the last weeks that we could make a conference since we would be one year old as a church. And if we do a conference why we wouldn't do as the big ones do: tags, invitation cards, conference fee....so finally with 8 pastors and 85 people we held the first and we believe not the last Transylvanian fall missions conference.

Now I would like to write about events in the church. Since we have been here for a year we can clearly see that the sower does his "job" with tears. Many times we feel that the only firm point in our lives is the Word of God, His Love, and the Love and Care we receive from our churches.

It is very sad that some families and people had left the church by the end of the summer. I hope that they will find a good church and they won't live their christian lives without The Body of Christ in the age of the church. I believe that now only those remained who understand something of the church and the goal of it. And hopefully these people become the spine of the church here.

And yet we are planting a church and the Bible is speaking about it!

Paul wrote about this age as a mystery and secret. And don't we agree with that? It is amazing that God sends blessing where unity is and where people come together in his name. He moves where Heavenly Vision is. (Psalm 133, Mt. 18:20, Proverbs 29:18). We have to understand that services and events in the church are not necessarily about fireworks, miracles and emotional experiences. Primarily we go to church not to fill our emotions but our mind.

So we are here and see that more and more people are looking for a kind of religion which can fit in their comfort and world view. We address people in this age, in this post modern age where everything is about experience and entertainment. How much we have to stand firm in our faith and encourage each other! We have to realize the age of apostasy and delusion around us (Mt 24:24) and stand in our convictions.

But we come together redeeming the time because the days are evil. (Ef. 5.16)

I believe that our little church is getting firmly established and we also got a new disciple: Nimród. His is a real Timothy. It is great to be with him and investing into his life.

We have great expectations concerning the winter season:

- First, Polina has arrived as a team member. Halleluja! With Ani we are amazed. She is the first inhabitant of the Missions House and we believe that it is just the beginning and boys will join the team soon.

- Secondly, we started the Hargita Missions which is practically a countryside outreach and bible study in Csikszereda on every second Saturday.

- Thirdly, at the end of November will be the first St. George foreign missions trip. We go to Kisinov to visit P. Mark and the church there.

- Fourthly, we are preparing to organize the Winter Harvest here. We are waiting for a team from Budapest after the Budapest winter conference. (January 6-12).
