

## ***GOD HAS SO MUCH OPPORTUNITIES FOR US!***

### **OUR PRIVILEGE: PROCLAIMING THE GOSPEL**

God has opened the doors for us in a flood victims evacuation center set up in our neighborhood. We met depressed and desperate people there. It is not easy to lose all his property and to have to rebuild one life again from scratch. The good news is that God is always with those who have a broken heart (Psalm 34:19).

We went to the evacuation center almost every day to listen and provide comfort and hope to those in need.

It is nice to see the body of Christ in action. Different churches have moved to assist evacuees. It was great to see the unity and compassion of Jesus Christ expressed by Christians from all sides.



### **I'd like to share this testimony which has touched me deeply:**

Tukkata and I discussed with a group of three people, two men and one woman. The discussion began with a "Hi!" Launched to us by one of the men. We headed to the group. The man, about forty, continued by asking "Are you Christian?". We answered "yes. Have you ever met Christians?" His answer: "Yes, my father became a Christian while dying of cancer in the hospital; the nurses told him about Jesus." "And what do you think about that?" We asked him. He replied: "I was really impressed by the change in the life of my father."

Then he told us that two years ago, his father died while he himself was in prison. He has heard the news seven months after, when his was release from prison. He has not yet been able to visit the grave of his father and feels guilty about that.

He also related that he was released from prison because of a special grace of the king. Tukkata immediately said something to him in Thai and to our surprise, this man started to cry. His two friends watched, helpless but aware that it was a special moment. The presence of God was there.

They became very attentive while we were talking about the goodness of God, the Sacrifice of Jesus Christ and of the fact that God wants to be with broken hearts. They prayed with us to receive the Lord and we gave them New Testaments and Jesus film DVDs. This was a unique moment.

After leaving, I asked Tukkata "what did you say to this man to make him cry like that?" She said "**Just as the king has done you this special grace to free you from the prison, God, your creator made you a special grace by offering his son and took away all your sins, and he wants you to be free**" Wow, what a powerful message!

We experimented several other stories like this one. God is at work. Let us keep all these flood victims in prayer so that many come to Christ.
